

Competitive Landscape

The worldwide market for UCaaS will grow from \$22.6 billion in 2022 to \$33.4 billion in 2027, at a CAGR of 8.1%.




- Nearly 6 out of 10 enterprises (58%) plan to increase spending on UC&C over the next 12 months (source: IDC's Future Enterprise Resiliency and Spending Survey, Wave 12, January 2023; n = 1,082).
- Roughly three-quarters (77%) of enterprises currently use or plan to use a BYOC approach to their communications and collaboration solution.
- UCaaS providers are focused on supporting migration from on-premises UC to multitenant, hosted cloud UC or dedicated, private cloud UC, facilitating hybrid implementations that allow businesses to shift to cloud-based UC at their preferred pace.
- Roughly 50% of enterprise buyers are looking for a single provider of their UCaaS solution along with commonly integrated solutions, such as web conferencing, a contact center, and even collaboration app software solutions (source: IDC's U.S. Enterprise Communications Services Survey, June 2021).
- Security and network quality matter to enterprise buyers, underscoring the value proposition that telecom service providers and cable companies deliver with their UCaaS solutions.



Competitive Landscape

Worldwide Unified Communications as a Service- Market Share by Vendor (1Q23)



- The ongoing migration to cloud-based voice along with significant and diverse unified communications and collaboration integration needs are changing the nature of UCaaS solutions and the competitive threats and opportunities to Telcos and Cable Cos.
- Even while UCaaS revenues have become challenged over the past year or two by commoditization as BYOC serves up its attractive yet market changing appeal to organizational buyers, buyers clearly prioritize voice integrated with broader communication and collaboration environments in the workplace.
 - **Microsoft's** UC&C revenues rose 20% year over year to \$6.8 billion in 2Q23, accounting for a 42.8% share of the market, up 40 basis points from 1Q23.
 - **Zoom's** UC&C revenue grew 2.5% year over year in 2Q23 to \$1.1 billion. It accounted for a 6.8% market share, staying relatively flat compared to 1O23.
 - **Cisco's** UC&C revenue fell 19.3% year over year in 2Q23 to \$951 million, but its market share grew, albeit just 11 basis points over 1Q23, to 6%.


Copilot in Teams meetings

Copilot in Teams Phone


Get real-time summarization and insights from your call.


Private Line

Private line is a new functionality for Teams Phone that allows you to enable a private second phone number for a select set of users so they can receive inbound calls directly, by passing delegates, admins, or assistants.

Calls to the private line are distinguished by a unique notification and ringtone.

Private line will be available later this year.




Click-to-Call


Click-to-call for Teams Phone enables customers to easily reach your organization—for example sales and support teams—directly from your webpage or app with a single click.

Your developers can add, customize, and program the widget to connect customers to a specific Teams user, call queue, or auto attendant, and the call recipient will receive the call directly in Teams.
